Statements Regarding CME Credits for Physician Coaching (Canada) Updated June 2022

The Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada

“As a member of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, you can claim credits in Section 3: Practice Assessment (3 credits per hour) for professional coaching. Proof of coaching is not required, but should be available if requested by the College. “At the CFPC, members can report credits for coaching if participating in a program reviewed and certified for Mainpro+ credits (most likely in the Assessment category). If not participating in an already-certified program, members could complete a reflective exercise (one of the “Linking Learning” series, most likely Linking Learning to Teaching or Linking Learning to Assessment) based on their coaching experience which would grant them 5 certified assessment credits.

Of note, we are currently in the process of reviewing our Assessment category and will be specifically looking at the concept of coaching and how to best reflect this in our credit reporting system.”
